

Ranch Roping Checklist - 2016

- Get CRRA approval (application on website) for your roping date(s).
- Print copies of membership/ waiver forms, entry sheets, current rules, score sheets and a payout sheet and schedule. You will need one score sheet for each team (open & novice) and you will need to have rule sheets posted at your roping. Score sheets must be filled in legibly with the first and last name of the roper and Open sheets must indicate who headed the animal. Any illegible/incomplete score sheets will not be included in the Hi-Point standings.
- Ropers must be prepared to show a current membership card or proof of purchase. **\$30** individual membership – **OR - \$50 FAMILY PLUS \$10** per family Member. Family membership is for husband, wife and youth children (14 years and under as of January 1st current year).
- You will need identification numbers (ear tags, face numbers or team penning tags) for your cattle, at the discretion of the host.
- You need to have at least **2** judges available.
- You need to have at least **2** people lined up to time, score keep and announce.

After the roping you will need to mail in:

- The completed waiver/membership form with membership money attached.
- All original score sheets, and a complete breakdown of your payout.

NOTE: The novice should be run after the open or midway through so the cattle are not fresh.

- When drawing extra ropers, never draw more than 2 people for the pick and draw (otherwise you're drawing a whole team).
